

Paper/Cardboard Recyclables

Place loose in Blue Box. Extra paper can be placed in a cardboard box, paper bag or other re-usable containers beside your blue box.

Acceptable recyclables are:

- Boxboard (cereal, tissue and detergent boxes)
- Catalogues, phone books and magazines
- Newspapers, flyers
- Envelopes and writing paper
- Corrugated cardboard, shoe boxes, brown paper bags
- Paper coffee trays
- Paper egg cartons

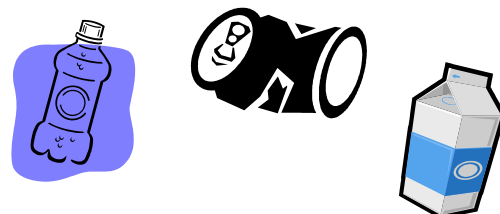


Metal, Plastics and Other Recyclables

Place clean containers loose in blue box.

Acceptable recyclables are:

- Aluminum cans, foil and plates
- Bread and milk bags and plastic grocery bags
- Glass jars (lids removed)
- Juice boxes, milk & juice cartons
- Tin cans
- Plastic containers & pop bottles (#'s 1-5, 7)
- Styrofoam #6
- Cardboard cans (frozen juice cans, chip & nut cans, refrigerated dough, baby formula, etc.)
