NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND PUBLIC MEETING

In the matter of Section 45 of the Planning Act, the Township of Madawaska Valley hereby gives Notice of an Application for Minor Variance

Subject Lands: 621B Kuiack Lake Road, being part of Lot 27, Concession 10, in the geographic Township of Radcliffe, Township of Madawaska Valley.

Purpose and Effect: The purpose and effect of the Minor Variance application is to reduce the required front yard depth from 7.5 metres to 3.66 metres to allow for the construction of a dwelling.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Township of Madawaska Valley Committee of Adjustment will hold a public hearing in accordance with Section 45 of the Planning Act on **August 5th, 2026 at 9:45 a.m.**

Participation: Any member of the public wishing to provide comments related to the application may do so in writing at any time prior to the meeting or orally during the meeting (in-person or virtual).

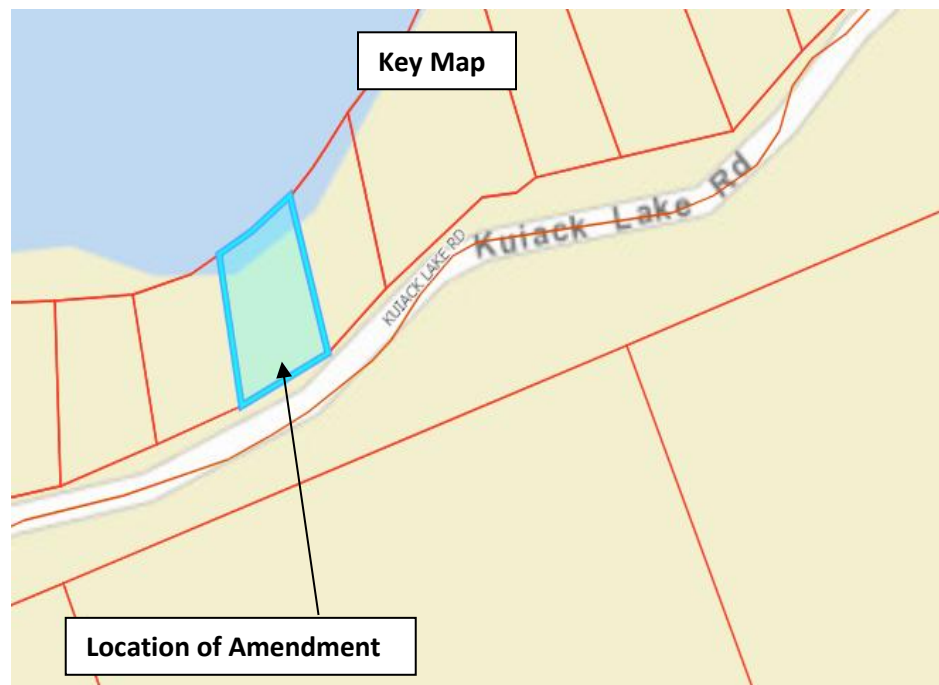
